# Advanced Whole Horse Dentistry Learning Center

## POLICIES

*Please read, sign and date:*

- Tuition is \$2250 for each class. To properly insure your experience is the best we can provide, class space must be reserved six weeks prior to the first day of class. This enables us to assemble a teaching staff that can meet the varied needs of multiple levels of students.
- For Level 2 and above, if you register after the one month cut off, there is a late registration fee of \$250 which is in addition to the tuition of \$2250.
- A deposit of 50% (\$1125) of the tuition is required one month prior to class to hold the student's space and must be accompanied by a signed registration form.
- Deposits are nonrefundable.
- In the case of a cancellation, the deposit (\$1125) can be transferred over to a future class for a period of 2 years from the date of cancellation.
- If we have 2 weeks notification prior to class and tuition has been paid in full we will refund 50% (\$1125) of the full tuition.
- Final full payment (\$2250 or \$2500) is due one week prior to the first day of class.
- If we have notification of cancellation ten days or less prior to the start of class tuition will be held for use on a future class for the period of two years from the date of cancellation.
- In the case of a medical emergency that is proven by documentation prior to the start of class we will refund 50% of the tuition (\$1125) if the tuition has been paid in full, and retain the deposit of \$1125 which can be used towards a future class within two years of the date of cancellation.
- Continuing education is required every two years for Certified students, but recommended every eighteen months.
- Cost of Continuing education for Certified students will be \$1450 in lieu of Assistant Instructor Program. 50% is due month in advance of class. (Modified February 13, 2009)
- Those students who, prior to Certification, do not continue their studies with Advanced Whole Horse Dentistry Learning Center for a period of one year will experience the following:
  - Being dropped from the Student List
  - Networking revoked
  - Will no longer be able to state that "I study with Advanced Whole Horse Dentistry"
  - All other students will be appraised of the loss of privileges and that you are no longer a part of the student body. This suspension of privileges will remain in effect until the student has contacted and returned to AWHD school.
- In regards to referrals, referrals will go to Certified students, in the case that there is no one available to cover an area, we will work our way down through Level 6, 5, and 4. Level 4 will be the lowest referral. (Level 4 by instructor approval.)
- Documentation of 50 hours study about the paradigm at your current level must be brought to class each time when you attend class for your next level and hand in on 1<sup>st</sup> day of class.
- Head and Neck Anatomy must studied from The Atlas Of Equine Anatomy, by C. Pasquini, V. K. Reddy, and M. Ratzlaff, and students will be tested.
- Students understand that Advanced Whole Horse Dentistry Learning Center may display and use any photographs taken for advertising, display, website and internet promotions.
